Benefits for Students:

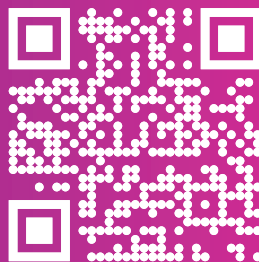
- **Showcase Career Opportunities**

- **Panel Sessions**
